Bills in the 2025 Legislature

SB 13 This bill would make it where Unions would not have to be registered with the KSSOS office. The unions ask that they still be required to register with the KSSOS office. At the hearing on this bill the KSSOS office ask for an amendment to have Unions still register their business agents with their office. Was amended to still have unions still register and was passed and signed into law.

SB 189 This bill would allow an injured employee to choose their health care provider for a work comp injury. No action taken.

HB 2024 This bill would allow for a tax credit for Firefighters for those have had unreimbursed expenses a cancer screening for job related cancer. This bill had a hearing but no action was taken.

HB 2130 This bill would allow for KPERS members to choose to be paid monthly are bi-weekly. This bill had a hearing but no action was taken.

HB 2372 Fallen Firefighter memorial. This bill makes the Firefighter Memorial in Wichita the official Firefighter Memorial for Kansas. It replaces the Firefighter memorial committee with the Firefighter Memorial advisory council. This was added to SB 199 that was the fireworks bill which allows permanent locations to sell all year around. This bill passed and was signed into law.
